More full bodied than the french this Californian classic still retains its delicate pinot style with brown sugar and cherry rhubarb notes - simply stunning!

Bertrand Berge Fitou 'Origines Languedoc, France

This is a wonderful example of the art of blending. Vibrant cherry and strawberry fruit from the grenache whilst the acidity, tannin and deeper colour are provided by the carignan. Purity and elegance in a bottle.





For that something special...

Champagne Louis Roederer Brut, Reims, France

More full bodied in style, this toasty number comes from the same makers of Cristal.

Alan Gautheron Colette Gros Chablis, France £36

A real classic, hints of apple and hazelnut. No Chablis drinker will be disappointed.

Greywacke Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, NZ
£40

A cult following in London for this New World stunner. Forget Cloudy Bay, this is Kevin Judd's new project. Tropical and a softer more delicate finish with a hint of citrus freshness.

Jean Reverdy et Fils Sancerre les Villots Rosé, Loire, France
£34

Consistently voted the best sancerre rosé by the revered "hachette guide" in France, this silky, strawberry and redcurrant scented pink is wonderfully fine.

Racemi Sinfarosa Zinfandel, Manduria, Italy
£35

The Primitivo grape isn't widely known but it produces smooth, ripe, fruit-driven wines. This one is multi-award winning and we can see why - truly delicious! (organic)

A lovely crisp, citrusy, dry white from an unusual grape popular in Navarra.

A classic, easy drinking example, perfect for every day.

Aromatic and floral with ripe apple flavours. This medium-bodied, dry white is perfect with seafood dishes.

A beautiful white from the south of Burgundy, rich tropical flavours alongside apricots. Similar to a Chablis but with a lovely subtle creaminess and a crisp finish.

The chef's choice - aromatic and fresh with classic flavours of passionfruit and gooseberry - he has good taste!

15. Riva Sangiovese, Veneto, Italy

Gorgeous salmon pink colour, with a bit of spice, a lovely summer rose!
